AutoCAD is a 2D drafting and 2D drawing program with an optional 3D modeling component, and it was the first CAD program to feature object-based and multilevel modeling capabilities. The program has more features than other 2D drafting and drawing applications, such as MS Office or QuarkXPress, because it was designed for the commercial CAD industry. The first version of AutoCAD introduced many new technologies that are still used today, including a history panel, which shows users the changes made to drawings during the past few years, and the ability to add comments to drawings that are exported for printing. Users can see how drawings are different between different versions of the program. Additionally, AutoCAD introduced a "visual programming" interface and a rudimentary form of object-based drawing that enabled users to draw features and parts as self-contained blocks. This was the first technology to enable users to effectively "stack" objects so they could be arranged in multiple layers and modified without breaking the rest of the drawing. AutoCAD is available in two editions: AutoCAD LT and AutoCAD LT/E. The LT edition is intended for non-technical users and has limited functionality, but can be used as a starter application for CAD design. The LT/E edition has many features intended for professional CAD users and includes the latest enhancements in 3D modeling. In addition to the desktop application, AutoCAD is available as a web-based application, which allows users to work online and share documents with colleagues. Additionally, AutoCAD has a subscription-based cloud service called AutoCAD 360 (formerly Autodesk Vault), which integrates AutoCAD drawing and CAD model data in the cloud for secure collaboration, easy access, and access on mobile devices. Autodesk Rescue will recover or repair a damaged or corrupt AutoCAD drawing. When AutoCAD is in the process of creating a drawing, it saves it in its project file format, which includes its drawing number and a date stamp. The system uses this number and the date stamp to name the resulting file. If the system's storage drive is damaged or corrupt, or if the operating system changes, the drawing project file format can change. This makes it difficult to recover the drawing from the system and then convert it into a format that is usable by other AutoCAD programs. The only solution is to recover and repair the AutoCAD drawing itself. Autodesk Revit, a free CAD software developed by Autodesk, introduced a new command, "Import External Database", which allows the user to import models and documentation (dxf, dwg, dwf) from an external source.
